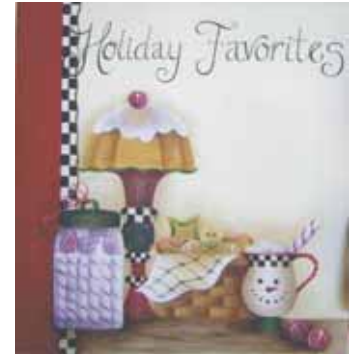

November 8, Rocky Teel will return with a Workshop.

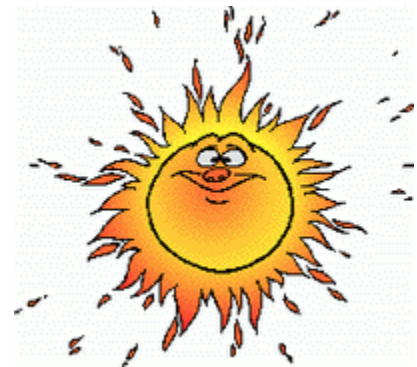
December 13 is our Holiday Party.

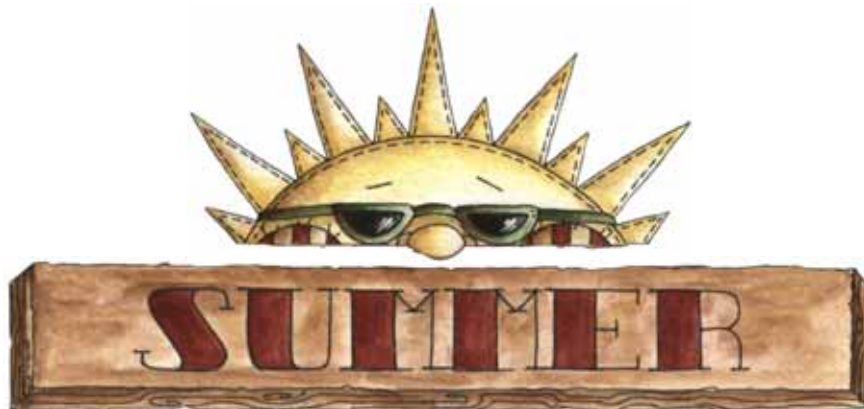

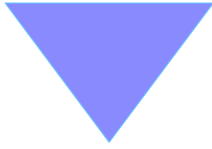
October is National Toile Month!!
