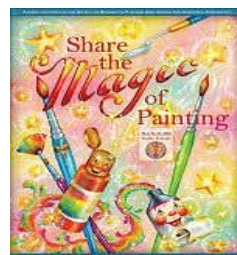

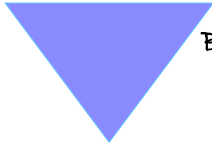


ways and means
