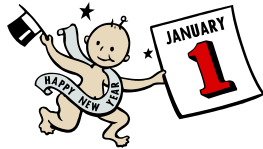

Hello Chapter Members,

I'm excited for this next year, we have so many neat projects for you all. I'm also excited to get to know everyone a little better.

In January we have Lourdes Lopez teaching a colored pencil class. If you haven't signed up yet and want to take this class, please let me know as soon as you can ; mail your \$10 to me to hold your spot—9353 Dancing Daffodil Avenue, Las Vegas, NV 89129. If you show up for the class, the money will be returned to you. It doesn't get any better than that. In February, I will be teaching a brush holder. Money is being collected now for this class. The cost is \$15 nonrefundable, so sign up as soon as you can or at the next chapter meeting in January.

Things to bring for Lourdes' class—  
Prismacolor pencils in the following colors: *French Grey 30%, French Grey 20%, French Grey 10%, Pumpkin Orange, Orange, Yellowed Orange, Goldenrod, Olive Green, Light Umber and Cream*; and Derwent Watercolor pencils in *Orange Chrome and Naples Yellow*. You will need a round template to use for your orange, as big or as small as you like, but not less than 3 1/2 inches; a kneaded eraser; and a pencil sharpener (one that holds the shavings). Hope everyone will be able to find what you will need; you can call Lourdes at 702-451-5989 if you need more help.

How blessed we all are to have such a fantastic circle of painting pals to spend time with painting and having fun each month.

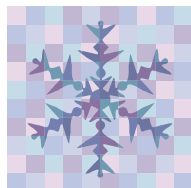

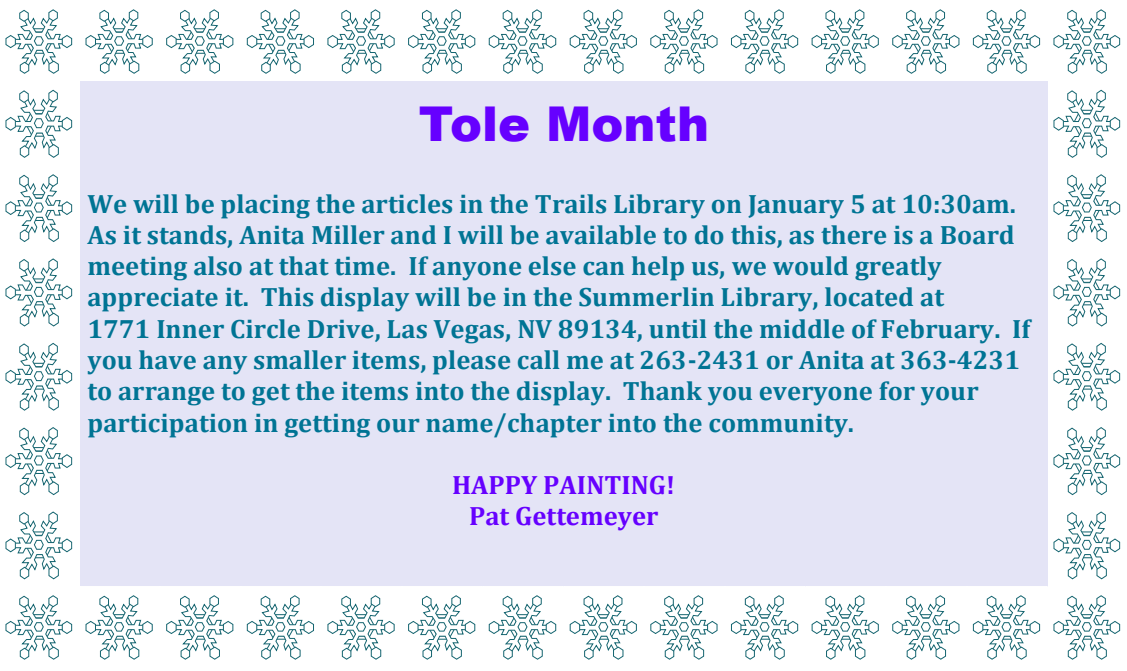


## *Holiday Party*

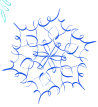
### SDP SURVEY
