Our Workshop for September 10 is full. Sharon Shuster is teaching *Folk Art In Blue*, a design by Maureen McNaughton. If you are signed up and do not have a pattern please call me so I can get one to you. Before class please have your project basecoated and the pattern applied. The basecoat color is Americana DC 142 Blue Green. If you don't have that color, use a 1:1 mix of JoSonja Pthalo Blue and Pthalo Green. Sharon will be supplying the wet palette system and special extender needed for this class.

Anita Miller is our teacher for the October 8 Paint-In. The project is "*Boo*" Pumpkin by Kelly Hoernig. It is painted on a pumpkin, but you may choose whatever surface you'd like. I have the instructions for this class, which is \$10, refundable upon attendance, so please sign up as soon as you can; I need a head count at the next meeting.

A reminder to those of you who have agreed to teach in 2012—by September please submit 2 to 3 pictures of a project you would like to teach. Pictures need not be of something you already painted. You can submit a picture out of a magazine, just a picture of something you would like to teach. In October the Board will select the projects for next year, so the more the merrier. We truly want next year to be a year full of great fun! If you are bringing a friend to the Chapter and they want to paint, please call me to let me know, so I can have enough patterns and instructions. My number is 702-838-2759.

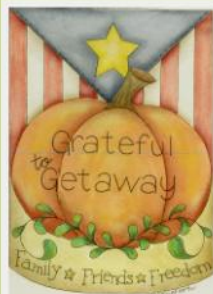

When painting flat surfaces that are smallish, such as, ornaments, pins, tops to boxes, put a piece of masking tape -folded over on itself- on top of a small paint bottle. This gives you easy access to paint all surfaces with a way to grip and not get paint all over me, I mean us. You can use any type of tape but masking tape works the best at holding the surface on the bottle.
